The Table below sets out the 2010 fisel mix by fast type and CO<sub>2</sub> emissions on an All-Island basis for Electric Ireland as a supplier focused in Ireland and Northern Ireland and Loperating in the Single Electricity Market (SEM). The overall All-Island fuel mix and CO<sub>2</sub> emissions is also shown for comparison purposes. All-Island fuel mix refers to the combined mix of electricity supplied in Ireland and Northern Ireland, including imports from Great Britain and generation operating outside the SEM in Ireland and Northern Ireland. The Table also shows the grams of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions per kWh of electricity supplied by Electric Ireland accross the island of Ireland as well as an overall average CO<sub>2</sub> emissions figure representative of the All-Island electricity market.
